A virtual IQAC meeting was held on 10.08.2022 at 2:00 P.M. It was attended by 16 members. Representatives from various fields, alumni, and faculty members actively participated in the meeting to deliberate on the following agenda:

- 2. Capacity Building Programmes

## **Deliberations of the meeting**

- Establishing a Research cum Incubation Centre: A briefing on the initiation of the process was given by Prof. Dr.Sr. Marry Kutty.P.J, Principal. Application for guideship at Ph.D level was submitted by seven of the faculty members to Osmania University on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2022. An inspection team visited the campus from the Osmania University. Members raised the issue of financial viability with regard to incubation center. Dr. Vijay Kumar Devarakonda suggested connecting with Technology Business Incubator (TBI) of OU for hand holding with respect to process, installation and mentoring for the ideas generated. Another body that could help and fund was RUSA. Bank loans from SBI and other financial agencies were other possibilities as suggested by Prof G.Surender Reddy. Dr. A. Goutam suggested it is important to process for income tax exemptions in order to facilitate external funding.
- 2. Capacity Building Programmes: A programme on happiness quotient was already conducted. The capacity building programme planned for the year included story board writing, crowd funding. Other suggestions were on developing communication skills, Individual social responsibility according to Retd Prof. Annie Pothen. Dr. C Aruna pointed that the State of Telangana ranks 32-35 according to National Achievement survey (2021). There were suggestions to collaborate with Telangana Academy for Skill and Knowledge (TASK) to identify skill gaps and develop required skill among teachers. Mrs. Hyacinth Emanuel suggested that, the faculty of the college

be porters/ resource persons in the areas prescribed by CBSE, Centre of Excellence, Southern, Chennai as part of capacity building programmes.

- 3. Webinars ahead: The two webinars planned for the year ahead included Social-Emotional Learning at ECCE phase and recent trends in humanistic research methodology. Details of the sessions and identified resource persons were informed to the members. Other areas suggested by Dr. T. Diana Jacob were Neuro Linguistic Programme (NLP), syntax disorder and errors in reading and writing.
- 4. **Memorandum of Understanding**: The members were briefed about the MoUs signed and activities undertaken in collaboration with them by Dr.K. Geetha.
  - NIHH: Masters Students completed an internship programme supported by the faculty.
  - Butterfly Edufields conducted a session on Stempreneurship in order motivate students to start STEM centers. Students visited the manufacturing unit to understand the process of designing and developing STEM Kits.
  - St.Ann's College of Education in collaboration with Australian Tutor Association (ATA) conducted an International webinar on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) for enhancing Professional Education.
  - Ghulam Ahmed College of Education: Academic Audit tool kit was developed.
  - Tutoroot: Students were selected for developing e-content, recording and online presentations
  - MSI: A survey was conducted by the B.Ed. students in collaboration with Montfort Social Institute. A session on Youth parliament was organised by the Montfort brothers in the college campus.
  - Socialised Society Servant (SSS): The institute conducted an awareness programme regarding women safety.
  - Rajgiri Media Center: Collaborating on developing and validating entrepreneurial pedagogy. An exercise on writing and publishing snippets is in progress.
- **5. NEP Preparedness:** The members were briefed about the chalked out strategic plan regards to implementation of NEP 2020 and ITEP model structure.
- 6. **Any other:** There were suggestions pertaining to Internship, Partnership, regular publications of newsletters, monthly journals etc. Pedagogical Research studies are to be focused upon.
