Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) Summary of Analysis 2019-2020

A. Opinion about the infrastructural facilities

Students rated the infrastructural facilities good to very good with average mean 2.3 on a 3-point scale. Slightly lower mean value was observed in context of canteen, gymnasium and sick room. A student-initiated canteen by science club members and social service club members was attempted. The profits going to the needy. Attempts are being made to upgrade the gymnasium. The sick room is facilitated with all emergency medicines and since the college is in the closest vicinity of Apollo/ Madhava hospitals, thus in case of any emergencies the patient is immediately shifted.

B. Rapport with human resources:

Most of the respondent expressed that they shared a very good rapport with management, faculty and all other faculties of interactions. The strongest rapport was observed among the principal, teaching faculty, peer group, mentor and master teacher. With minimum interaction with contingent staff the mean value was lowest.

E. The degree of change observed in self:

Interpretation: The responses indicate a significant level of dispositions. The highest mean observed in following rules, politeness and courtesy, cleanliness followed by abiding by confidence level time management.
