IPR in the field of Higher Education primarily focuses on the policy towards promoting innovations and creativity by awakening the entrepreneur within the teacher fraternity. The University Grants Commission, the nodal authority for determining and maintaining standards of University Education in India has mandated the inclusion of IPR as a generic elective subject under the Choice Based Credit System. The National Institutional Ranking Framework acting as a mechanism for educational institutions in promoting innovations, research and development has brought within the ambit of IPR: educational services and products such as publications, professional practices and educational processes to be accorded the same protection as other industries.



Inventions, literary and artistic works, designs and symbols, names and images used in commerce are protected under the IPR nationally and globally enabling individuals to earn recognition and/or financial benefit for inventions and creation.

is

established in other areas, its scope and implications on teacher education in the Indian context with emphasis on administration and management for human capital development is made possible through this Webinar.
